KEEPING YOUR CHILD SAFE

Dear Awana Parent,

Keeping your child safe is a cooperative effort that requires everyone's attention and consideration. Thank you for noting the following rules and procedures.

Things WE do to keep your child safe:

- All Awana Leaders must adhere to our Child Protection Policy and submit to a yearly background check.
- Provide a Door Man/Security Guy on duty at all times.
- Conduct yearly fire drills.

Things YOU do to keep your child safe:

- Properly register your child by including emergency phone numbers and medical information.
- Park your car and escort your child to, and from the church building. Do not drop-off or pick-up your child at the curb. Curbside drop-off and pick-up is dangerous, and can be ticketed.
- Do the proper Check-In and Check-Out procedure for your child's club. (No child shall leave the building without an adult).
 - ✓ Cubbies Check-In and Check-Out in the Nursery on the second floor.

- ✓ Sparks Check-In in the Basement and Check-Out in the Auditorium on the main floor.
 - ✓ T&T Boys and T&T Girls Check-In by the Teen Room on the 3rd floor and Check-Out in the Basement. (T&T Boys and T&T Girls can Check-In without a parent).
